CLASSROOM SUPPORT

This parent helper would assist the teacher and students with in-class routines and duties. Volunteers are asked for a one-hour commitment each week.

CLASSROOM MATH HELP

This parent helper would assist the teacher and students with in-class math

assignments and classroom work. Volunteers are asked for a one-hour commitment each week.

CLASSROOM WRITING HELP

This parent helper would assist the teacher and students with in-class writing assignments and classroom work. Volunteers are asked for a one-hour commitment each week.

CLASSROOM READING HELP

This parent helper would assist the teacher and students with in-class reading assignments and classroom work. Volunteers are asked for a one-hour commitment each week.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION SUPPORT

Are you looking for a way to get some physical activity into your day? Volunteers are needed to support the physical education teacher during gym class. Help prepare the environment, supervise students, and clean up. With large class sizes, this volunteer will help keep our students safe.

ART SUPPORT

Volunteers are needed to support the art teacher during art class each month. Help prepare the environment, distribute materials, collect finished artwork, and clean up.

LIBRARY SUPPORT

Library volunteers enjoy a calm atmosphere among a wonderful collection of books (and people). Help is needed with checkout and check-in and returning the books to their places on the shelves. In addition, we always need help with repairing and processing books and materials and assisting students.

COMMUNITY SERVICE SUPPORT
